Clubhouse Rentals

Too many relatives and friends to host your party at home? The clubhouse is available for rentals 365 days a year, even on holidays! You can view our rental calendar at www.oakslanding.org or by calling the clubhouse at 636-225-2183.

The clubhouse only accepts checks for payment.

The clubhouse rental prices are:

Monday - Thursday	\$25 per hour
Friday - Sunday	\$35 per hour
Holidays	\$45 per hour

A deposit check of \$150 is also required per rental.

A minimum of 4 hours is required for all rentals. Set up and take down time are included in the 4 hours. If additional time is needed, appropriate rental fee applies.

For example, if you reserve from 11 am – 3 pm, you may begin set up at 11 am and you must be cleaned up and out by 3 pm. We need one hour for our staff to clean between rentals so please make sure you give yourself enough time. Thank you in advance for your consideration of the rental following yours.

Non Profit Organizations - require a \$25 deposit check

\$15 for 2 hours and each additional hour is \$10.

Non profits may rent the clubhouse during normal business hours Monday - Friday.

NOTE: Only members of Oaks Landing Recreational Association may rent the Clubhouse and members must be present during the entire rental time

Please remember residents must have their OLRA ID with them when using any of the Recreational Association facilities. If you have not had a chance to get your ID, stop by the clubhouse to have one made. In most cases, ID cards can be issued while you wait. You will need to provide proof of residence in the form of a current driver's license. ID cards are provided free of charge from January through March. Meeting Minutes

June 2024

An open OLRA meeting was held on July 1 st , 2024. All Board Members and five residents were present.

We would like to thank past OLRA President Frank Roberts for his dedication and endless hours of work for this association. Frank was the go-to guy when anything needed to be done, and he never hesitated to stop what he was doing and respond to the clubhouse to fix a problem.

Taking Frank's place as the new OLRA President will be Rich Garner and Andrew Seibert will fill the vacant spot on the Remington Oaks side of the board.

MANAGER'S REPORT

- * Several recent expenses include work on the deck, bathroom updates, tree removal, a gym purchase, and unexpected pool work.
- * The last day to pay 2024 Assessments is July 31 st . Liens will be filed in August. At the time of this report, there are five outstanding Assessments.
- * There were 5 Profit rentals and 4 Non-Profit rentals in the month of May.

CLUBHOUSE

- * Residents will be required to show their ID Cards when using any part of the facility. This should have already been common practice, but it will start being enforced. If you or a family member need an ID Card, please contact the Clubhouse Management during normal business hours.
- * New pickleball paddles were ordered to replace the broken paddles. A new treadmill was also purchased and is ready for use in the gym.
- * There will be a Popsicle Parade on July 4 th , starting at the clubhouse at 10 a.m. The Fenton Fire Department will lead the parade, and kids will get popsicles at the end. Kids are encouraged to decorate their bikes prior to the parade.

*Clubhouse Manager Connie and two Board Members have been added to the banking account for oversight reasons. Two Board Members were also given keys to the Clubhouse for emergency response if needed.

* A resident mentioned that the wooden benches at the pickleball courts are starting to show some wear and tear. The benches will be looked at, and if necessary, they will be fixed. Someone also mentioned that the wi-fi connection was spotty at the clubhouse and around the pool. We will be looking at costs and solutions to fix this problem.

POOL

*A replacement handrail for the adult pool has been ordered and will be installed as soon as it arrives.

* To accommodate neighboring homes, music will not be played at the pool until 12pm Monday-Thursday.

*August 24 th at 4 p.m. will be the end-of-the-year neighborhood pool party.

It was brought to our attention that the clock at the pool does not always work so a new clock will be ordered.

* We are still looking for a neighborhood resident to step up and be the pool lifeguard during the morning and afternoon hours in August. If we cannot find someone to fill these times, the pool will remain closed until later in the day. This is due to the high school and college-aged lifeguards going back to school.

* The pool will be closing at 7 p.m. on Thursday, July 4 th for a staffing shortage.

* Due to an unexpected pool closure in Pacific, the Oaks Landing Stingrays requested from the OLRA Board that the swim meet be moved to our pool. After a vote from the OLRA Board, the move was allowed. The pool will be closed at 3 p.m. on July 8 th to accommodate this event.

ROHA Board Updates June 2024

The Board is pleased to announce that we have received the necessary votes to approve the ballot initiatives to the Remington Oaks Indentures. We received 283 votes to approve and 35 votes to reject. Voting for this initiative is now closed. The board has contacted our attorney to complete the process of submitting this information to St. Louis County. Thank you to all of our residents who took the time to vote on this issue.

The Board is pleased to announce that Joe Ray has been voted on to the Remington Oaks Homeowners Assoc Board. Joe will serve as the Common Ground Trustee. We welcome Joe to the Board and look forward to working with him.

Now that summer is here, we see more golf carts around the neighborhood and thought it would be a good idea to remind golf cart owners/drivers of some of the requirements and rules of the road or Missouri.

Golf Cart Safety*

- **A golf cart is a motorized vehicle.** Like any other vehicle, golf carts are subject to the same statutes and restrictions that govern vehicles driven on public streets. Under Missouri law, only licensed drivers over the age of 16 years may operate a golf cart on a public street. And, like automobile drivers, a golf cart driver has the legal duty to use the highest degree of care when operating the vehicle. Accordingly, a golf cart driver must drive the vehicle as a very careful person would under the same or similar circumstances.
- **Golf carts drivers must also follow Missouri's rules of the road.** Golf cart drivers must comply with all state and local laws applying to the driving of motorized vehicles. Operators of golf carts must comply with traffic control devices like stop signs, operate the vehicle on the right side of the road, and park the golf cart along, parallel and near the curb. Golf carts cannot be driven on sidewalks and must be equipped with certain safety equipment, such as mirrors. Passengers should wear seat belts.
