Clubhouse Rentals

Too many relatives and friends to host your party at home? The clubhouse is available for rentals 365 days a year, even on holidays! You can view our rental calendar at www.oakslanding.org or by calling the clubhouse at 636-225-2183.

The clubhouse only accepts checks for payment.

The clubhouse rental prices are:

Monday - Thursday	\$25 per hour
Friday - Sunday	\$35 per hour
Holidays	\$45 per hour

A deposit check of \$150 is also required per rental.

A minimum of 4 hours is required for all rentals. Set up and take down time are included in the 4 hours. If additional time is needed, appropriate rental fee applies.

For example, if you reserve from 11 am – 3 pm, you may begin set up at 11 am and you must be cleaned up and out by 3 pm. We need one hour for our staff to clean between rentals so please make sure you give yourself enough time. Thank you in advance for your consideration of the rental following yours.

Non Profit Organizations - require a \$25 deposit check

\$15 for 2 hours and each additional hour is \$10.

Non profits may rent the clubhouse during normal business hours Monday - Friday.

NOTE: Only members of Oaks Landing Recreational Association may rent the Clubhouse and members must be present during the entire rental time

Please remember residents must have their OLRA ID with them when using any of the Recreational Association facilities. If you have not had a chance to get your ID, stop by the clubhouse to have one made. In most cases, ID cards can be issued while you wait. You will need to provide proof of residence in the form of a current driver's license. ID cards are provided free of charge from January through March. Oaks Landing Recreational Association Meeting Minutes June 2025

There were no residents that showed up for the open meeting.

Andrew Siebert has taken over as the President of the OLRA Board.

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- Front door of the clubhouse has been fixed.
- Lights in the men's room and downstairs were replaced.
- Gap in the pool fence was fixed.
- There are four new employees at the clubhouse.
- The annual Patriotic Popsicle Parade is happening on July 4th. Thank you to Danielle Bayer with Strano Real Estate for sponsoring this event.

April Clubhouse Rentals: 8 Profit 2 Non-Profit

- There are 2 swim events in July.
- Several teenagers broke into the swimming area on June 13th and threw pool deck items into the pool.
- End of the summer pool party is August 16th.
- There was a discussion about adding extra surveillance cameras at the clubhouse.
- We are looking at updating the water fountains at the clubhouse and pool.
- September 7th is going to be a volunteer day, and we will be asking people in the neighborhood to meet at the clubhouse and help tidy things up.

A Message from the Remington Oaks HOA

* **Lake Remington** – The May storms did some damage to the spillway on the lake. The repairs that were made earlier in the year replacing the grates and installing a fence around the spillway box were heavily damaged. ROHA is now faced with making additional repairs and modifications. Work to replace the grates and fence will begin sometime later in the summer. Based on the initial spillbox repair estimate we do not foresee the need, currently based on reserves, for a sewer assessment to be implemented but if additional repairs are required, all homeowners are being made aware that a sewer assessment may be enacted on all members of Villages of Remington Oaks HOA. An example of 25,000 assessment would be \$59.52 per lot. In addition, due to the flooding, the walking path around the lake has also experienced damage and we will be working with DJM Environmental to clean up the path as well as remove some of the overgrowth and review the plantings and any additional work that may need to be done.

* We also have a few homeowners who have not yet paid their dues. Two properties have had outstanding dues for over five years. We are currently collaborating with our legal counsel to encourage the homeowners to remit their payments to the Association. We will be issuing lien notifications to several homes due to unpaid assessments. ROHA depends on everyone doing their fair share by submitting their assessments on time. When the Association does not receive the full amount of funds requested, it creates difficulties for the other homeowners who comply with their obligations by paying their dues.

* Our Common Ground Trustee, Joe Ray, has been working with County Tree Services to trim and/or remove dead trees.

* The Board budgeted for FY2025 to restore a common area cul-de-sac. The work is now finished, and we thank and appreciate the homeowners in that circle for watering the new plants.
